Continue straight for .1 mile on Linden Avenue and turn left on to West Peachtree Street. Travel .3 mile and turn left onto Fifth Street. Go one block and turn left on to Spring Street (Barnes & Noble at Georgia Tech Bookstore on your left and the Georgia Tech Hotel on your right). Proceed a half block and turn right at the next light into the parking deck. Park on the second level (blue level). From there, enter the Georgia Tech Global Learning Center (84 Fifth St. N.W.).
