What Makes a good submission?

We are excited you are interested in collaborating with us! Hogan looks for the following criteria in research proposals we accept:

- A fully flushed out, formal research proposal. This should be similar to how you would write a thesis/dissertation proposal or any other academic research proposal.
- A brief literature review that clearly explains why your study should be conducted and makes sense to be conducted.
- Hypotheses or research questions that are clearly derived from the literature review.
- A methods section that details how you intend to conduct your study (e.g., using archival data, collecting your own data), who will be in your study sample, what is the intended timeline for this project, and why do you want/need to use the Hogan assessments specifically (as opposed to other measures of personality).
- A proposed analyses section. Specifically, what analyses will you conduct and how will these answer your hypotheses.

We highly recommend drafting your submission first in a Word document and then copying and pasting the information into our application.

Once you fill out the application the Academic research network associates will receive your proposal and have up to two weeks to provide feedback.

Upon review, one of three things may happen:

1. We will accept your proposal and move forward with it
2. We will ask for more clarification from you, prior to deciding
3. We will reject your proposal

It is important to note, that although we are happy to answer any questions you may have about the Hogan suite of assessments, we are not research advisors and are unable to answer questions about the design of your study, how to improve it, etc.

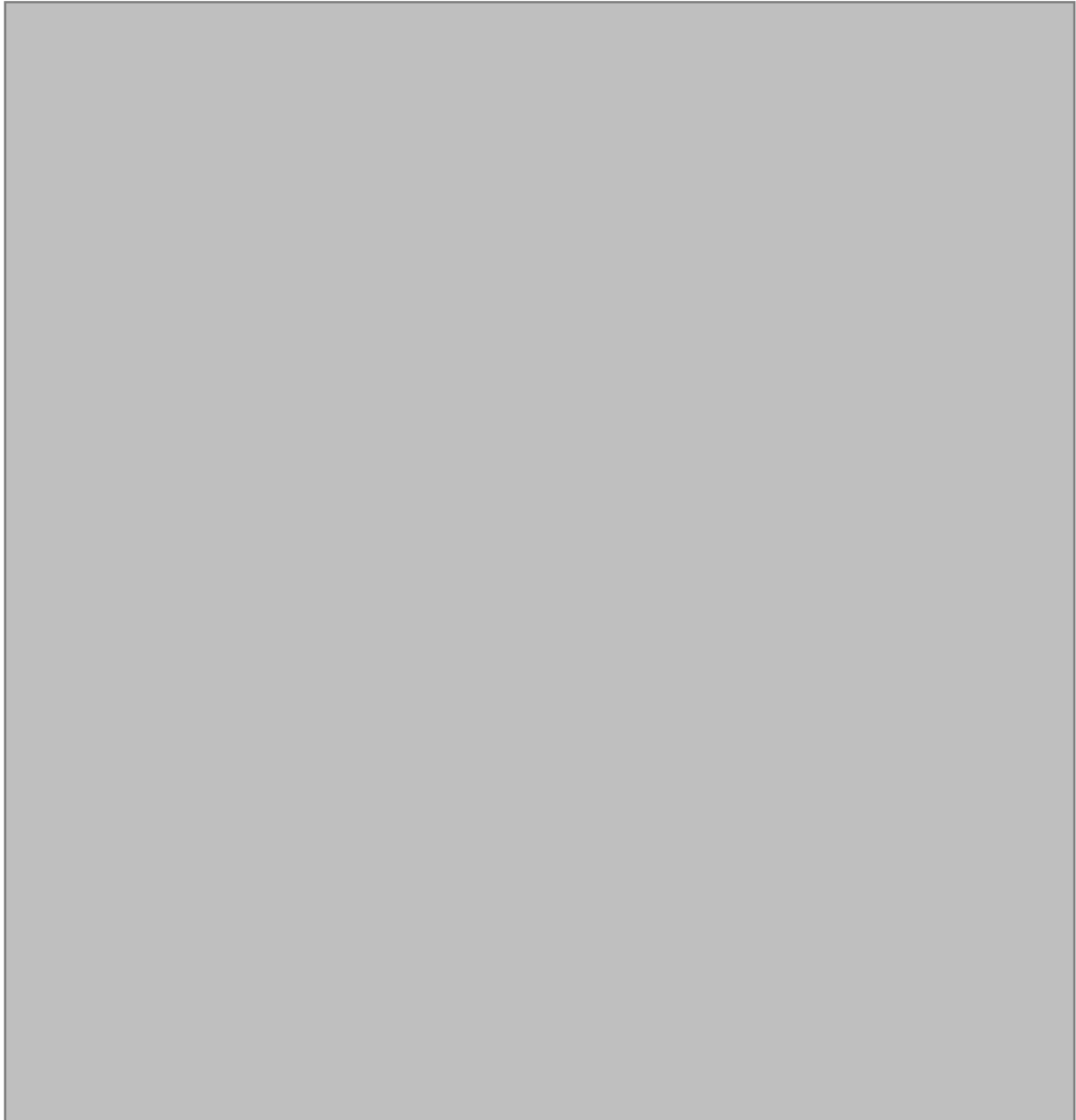

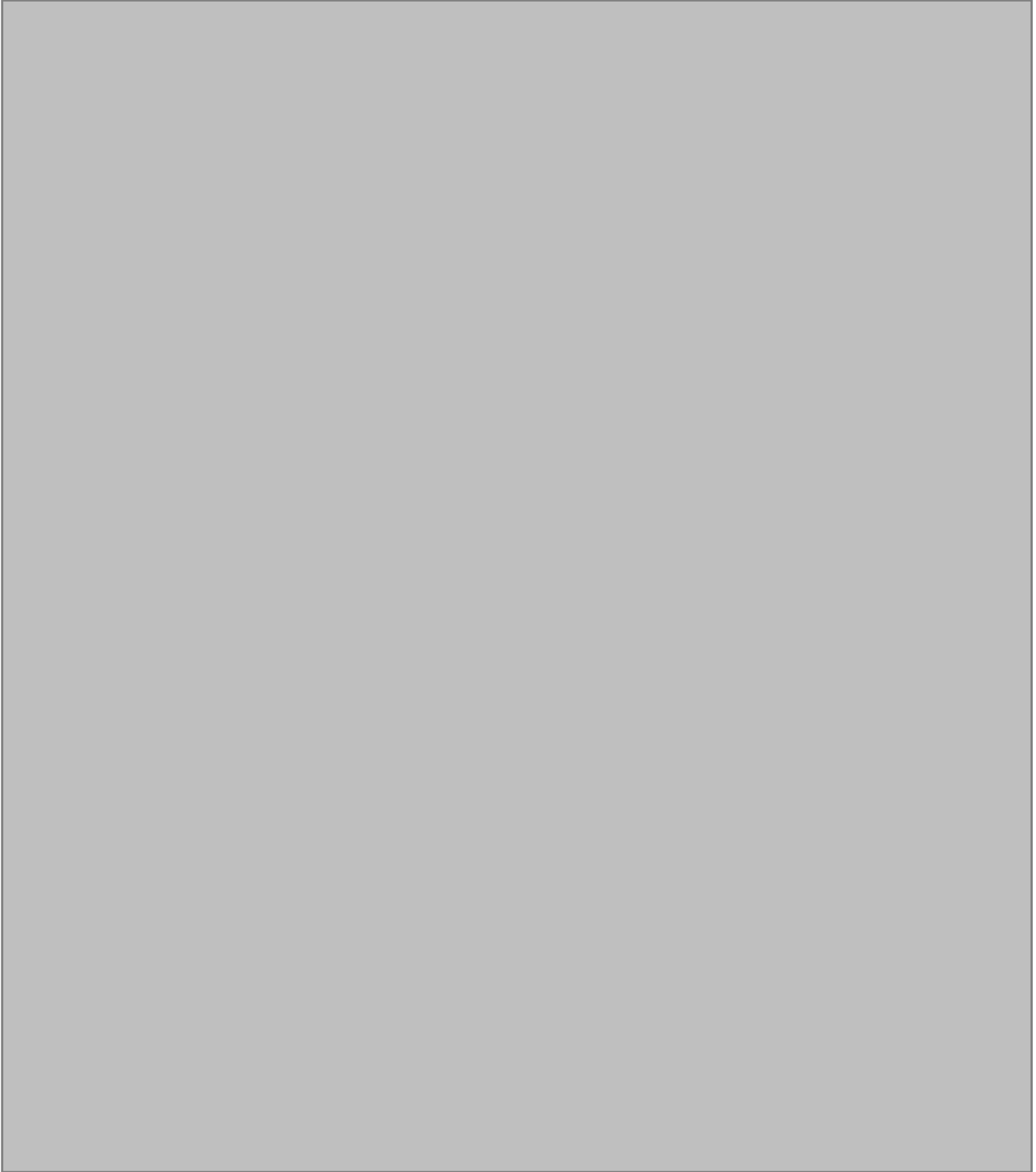
